Sunday September 13, 2020, “USA Today” reported that nine people were confirmed dead in California since lightning-caused fires that started weeks ago fused into a monster blaze and nearly destroyed Berry Creek, a small town northeast of San Francisco. The fires have spread over the state of California from Los Angeles and Napa-Sonoma wine country to Portland, Oregon with thousands fleeing their homes and many dying or missing.
